## The Practice/ The Area

A semi-rural Practice set in the heart of Kinvr Village, looking after approximately 5,400 patients from the Kinver, Wollaston, Bobbington and Enville areas.

The Practice is in a prime location within the main High Street of Kinver and is an NHS Property Company-owned health centre, which is single storey. It is a 1960s building which is in need of refurbishment and our aim for the future would be to be able to have a new purpose built practice in order to deliver even more patient services on site. We are currently very restrictive with space for us to continue to expand our services, but we are meeting with CCG to look at these future plans.

The Practice area extends within the boundary of South Staffordshire (our responsible authority); Dudley and Hereford & Worcester and is a member of the South East Staffordshire and Seisdon Peninsular Clinical Commissioning Group.

Kinver has a large proportion of commuters working in Birmingham and further a field. In the main it is an affluent area with a high proportion of professionals and those owning their own businesses. There are no areas of deprivation.

The list size continues to increase with a high elderly population, which is 50% higher than South Staffordshire practice average.

The Practice was previously run by South staffordshire PCT and in March 2007, following a successful tender, the Partners at Moss Grove Surgery were awarded a PMS contract. We are pleased to say that the contract has continued to be renewed and our list is still rising and has doubled since we took over the practice.

Sonia Clark who is also managing Kinver Practice became a partner in the practice from March 2007.

### The Patients

We currently care for 5400 patients. It is predominantly a middle-class semir-rural populatin Our patient list is predominantly white british, with very few ethnic minorities, we have an even split of male/female patients and higher than average eldelry population. As a Practice we look after several care homes and provide ward rounds. We also have patients with learning difficulties/ mental health needs, who are living within the community mostly within mental health residential care homes.

### Access/adaptations/equipment and facilities

Our aim is to offer an appointment within 48 hours where possible, however we also have appointments available on the day for 'emergencies' and a patient can see our Practice Nurse/ Healthcare Assistant on the day for services appropriate to them. It is our policy to always see children on the same day. We have also introduced telephone consulation slots where these are appropriate for our patients and also provide extended hours late sessions on Monday evenings for patients who are at work or find it difficult for relatives to bring them/ attend with them during the daytime surgery hours.

The Practice provides the following equipment; Defibrillator, ECG machine, emergency rescuscitation trolley, Spirometry, Ear Syring, Pulse Oximeters, 24 hour BP monitor, Hearing loop system, Smoke Analyser, Minor Surgery equipment / fully equipment consulting rooms
